Dear parishioners,

While it is hard for me to believe that so many years have gone by, this Tuesday (May 30) marks the 25th anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood. I am overwhelmed with gratitude to Jesus Christ for the life to which He has invited me, for the opportunity to serve in this vocation. Through parish ministry, work on archdiocesan activities and the various other encounters that result from serving as a priest I have been privileged to witness the goodness of God and the wonders of faith in so many ways.

I have spent almost 14 years of my priesthood here at Guardian Angel parish. So I'm really happy that this is where I get to celebrate my 25th anniversary. On Tuesday May 30th, I'll celebrate our 9 a.m. chapel Mass and be pleased to share some light refreshments in the rectory afterwards for those who can join us.
