We are once again organizing a service project to provide weekend meals to families served by the Oasis After-School Program. With your help, last year we delivered over 100 meals!

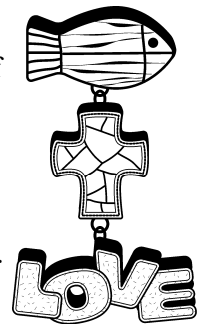

## SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Jesus' prayer to his Father at the Last Supper, heard in today's Gospel from John, is a solemn yet tender expression of love for his disciples. Jesus in effect asks his Father to be father to them, as the Father is to Jesus. As father, God will protect and unify them during the difficult times ahead. As father, God will share God's joy with them, as Jesus knew. Although asking that the disciples be protected from evil, Jesus also prays that the disciples not hide from the world, but fully engage with the world. During Jesus' ministry, although he spent much time forming a community of disciples and friends, he also regularly reached out to others, especially those at the margins of society. Jesus' prayer extends to us, that we his followers experience the fatherhood of God. Together with this fatherhood, we experience God's family. We discover brothers and sisters in Christian community. And we serve in the world, in our common human identity as God's children.
